

I-37 Nueces River Bridge Reconstruction Notice/Updates

- **NEW! Northbound I-37 *** Accessing Labonte Park*****
Please be advised. **Bridge height clearance is 12ft 6in to access Labonte Park through the I-37 Frontage Road going northbound from either using the Redbird exit or the Sharpsburg exit.** If your vehicle height exceeds the bridge height clearance, you will **not** be able to access Labonte Park going northbound. We advise you to take Exit 17, 77 North/Sinton/Victoria, going northbound and turn left on the first turnaround to get back onto I-37 going southbound and exiting on Exit 16, Labonte Park, for a worry free exit – as there is no height clearance on that side of the road. **Please plan accordingly.** [View Labonte Park map for more details.](#)
- **NEW! Southbound I-37 Labonte Park exit ramp**
As of 11/23/21, contractors will close the southbound I-37 Sharpsburg Road/Redbird Lane exit ramp beginning at 9pm Monday, 11/29/21. The ramp will remain closed until the construction of a temporary ramp is completed in fall 2022. Until the temporary ramp opens, southbound motorists may use the Labonte Park exit (Exit 16) and continue on the frontage road to access Sharpsburg or Redbird. **A detour map is attached.** Motorists are urged to slow down in the work zone and be alert to workers, slow-moving heavy equipment and traffic control devices such as concrete barriers. All work is weather permitting. Lane closures are subject to change without notice.
- **NEW! Northbound I-37 Labonte Park exit ramp**
As of 10/15/21, the exit ramp will remain closed until the new temporary exit ramp opens around the end of this year. Northbound I-37 drivers may use the Redbird exit and northbound US 77 drivers may use the Sharpsburg exit instead.
