Labonte Park Camping Rules and Regulations

Any conduct which constitutes a violation of Texas law, an ordinance of this city, the rules promulgated by the director, or a direction by the director or other authorized city employee as governed by <u>City Code of Ordinance Section 36 Parks, Recreation, Cultural and Leisure time Activities (Ord. No. 20377)</u> shall constitute grounds for expulsion from the park or public area.

- Park Curfew: 10pm 6am—City Noise ordinance enforced <u>City Code of Ordinances: Chapter 31</u> <u>Noise</u> (Ord.No.027440)
- Camping allowed by **PERMIT ONLY**, permit must be displayed at campsite.
- One campsite reservation is allowed per customer.
- RV campsites 1-15 are 50 feet wide and allow one RV per campsite.
- Two (2) **campsite vehicle parking permits** will be issued with each campsite packet at the time of check-in. Distribution of campsite vehicle parking permits will be the responsibility of the customer. Vehicles without a campsite vehicle parking permit will not be allowed entry. Campsite parking permits must be visible through the front windshield of the vehicle.
- Additional parking permits will <u>not</u> be available for purchase at Labonte Park. Up to two additional parking permits will be available for purchase online, at \$6.00 each, at time of reservation.
- Parking for non-campsite vehicles will be in a designated area at the north end of the park. No vehicles will be allowed entry into the park without either a campsite or non-campsite parking permit. Non-campsite parking permit must be visible through the front windshield of the vehicle.
- NO LIFEGUARDS ON DUTY--Children must be supervised at ALL times.
- Dogs must be on leash & owners must pick up pet wastes.
- The following are not permitted:
 - Littering
 - Livestock
 - Alcohol
 - Motorized vehicles (ATV, go-carts, motor-bikes or scooters)
 - Glass containers
 - Fireworks or camp fires
 - Mowing within the park and/or vegetation along the bank of the Nueces River
- There is NO ELECTRICITY OR WATER available at campsites.
- There will be a limited number of portable toilets made available for public use.
- Customers are responsible for cleaning the reserved campsite area after use and disposing of all trash in receptacles.
- CHECK OUT BY SUNDAY, April 20, 2025

Notice:

- City of Corpus Christi is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- Cancellations will only be accepted from the person who made the reservation.
- Cancellations shall be refunded if the reservation is canceled at least two (2) weeks before the date of the arrival.
- There are no refunds for bad weather. You are allowed to reschedule due to bad weather within 30 days of the original date for any available date within the next 12 months.
