## I-37 Nueces River Bridge Reconstruction Notice (Updates by Texas Department of Transportation, TxDOT)

Motorists are urged to slow down in the work zone and be alert to workers, slow-moving heavy equipment and traffic control devices such as concrete barriers. Lane closures are subject to change without notice.

*(pin set over Labonte Park – select ‘Satellite’ view, search ‘Labonte Park, Interstate 37, Corpus Christi’ from the ‘Drive Texas’ menu, click on ‘orange line’ next to the ‘Labonte Park’ label on map to learn more).*

## Getting to Labonte Park – Three Options

Due to the construction work by TxDOT, there is obstruction to access Labonte Park on either side of I-37.

**There is only one entrance to Labonte Park through the underpass of I-37 via the northbound I-37 Frontage Road (access road) where there is a bridge height (vertical) clearance of 18ft - 0in. If your RV and/or vehicle height exceeds the bridge height (vertical) clearance, you will not be able to access Labonte Park and you will be stuck at the underpass.**

## Option 1 of 3 – Getting to Labonte Park

### Driving in from Corpus Christi on I-37 heading North to Labonte Park

Please plan accordingly. [View map of Labonte Park on \(Google Maps\)](#).

**CAUTION – Exit 16, I-37 North, to Labonte Park is closed.**

- From any roadway of your choice in Corpus Christi, head north on I-37.
- Take **Exit 14 B, (Redbird Ln)**, heading north. \*
- Redbird Lane will merge and convert to **I-37 Frontage Road** (northbound access road).
- Continue and follow the **I-37 Frontage Road** (northbound access road) which will take you to Labonte Park.
- **CAUTION – Do not follow the northbound exit ramp as you will get on I-37 heading north.**
- **Please note.** Upon arrival, before entering Labonte Park, at the end of the I-37 Frontage Road (northbound access road), **there is a bridge height (vertical) clearance of 18ft - 0in. If your RV and/or vehicle height exceeds the bridge height (vertical) clearance, you will not be able to enter Labonte Park and you will be stuck at the underpass.**

#### **\* If you missed taking Exit 14B going north toward Redbird Lane –**

- Continue heading north on I-37.
- Take **Exit 20B**, going north (*about a 6-mile drive which is about a 5-minute drive*).
- Continue on Exit 20B ramp, turn right, then first left to get onto bridge overpass.
- Continue on bridge overpass, turn right, then right again to get onto I-37 going south.
- Take **Exit 16, I-37 South. Please note. There is no southbound exit into Labonte Park.**
- Please follow TxDOT signs to exit from I-37 South leading to **Ripple Road**.
- **CAUTION – At highway exit ramp, check for traffic exiting from Labonte Park heading toward Ripple Road.**
- From **Ripple Road**, turn left.
- Go through the underpass of I-37 and turn left.
- Keep on the **I-37 Frontage Road** (northbound access road) to get to Labonte Park.
- **CAUTION – Do not follow the northbound exit ramp as you will get on I-37 heading north.**
- **Please note.** Upon arrival, before entering Labonte Park, at the end of the I-37 Frontage Road (northbound access road), **there is a bridge height (vertical) clearance of 18ft - 0in. If your RV and/or vehicle height exceeds the bridge height (vertical) clearance, you will not be able to enter Labonte Park and you will be stuck at the underpass.**

## Option 2 of 3 – Getting to Labonte Park

Driving in from Kingsville on I-69E heading North to Labonte Park

Please plan accordingly. [View map of Labonte Park on \(Google Maps\)](#).

**CAUTION – Exit 16, I-37 North, to Labonte Park is closed.**

- From any roadway of your choice in Kingsville, head north on US-77.
- Continue and follow US-77 which converts to I-69 heading north (*about a 29-mile drive which is about a 25-minute drive*).
- Look for and follow sign (**North 37/77 San Antonio/Victoria**).
- **CAUTION – Do not take exit south toward Corpus Christi.**
- Prepare to exit next, keep right on ramp.
- Exit and follow sign (**Sharpsburg Road**). \*
- Sharpsburg Road will merge and convert to **I-37 Frontage Road** (northbound access road).
- **CAUTION – Do not follow the northbound exit ramp as you will get on I-37 heading north.**
- Continue and follow the **I-37 Frontage Road** (northbound access road) which will take you to Labonte Park.
- **Please note.** Upon arrival, before entering Labonte Park, at the end of the I-37 Frontage Road (northbound access road), **there is a bridge height (vertical) clearance of 18ft - 0in. If your RV and/or vehicle height exceeds the bridge height (vertical) clearance, you will not be able to enter Labonte Park and you will be stuck at the underpass.**

**\* If you missed taking the exit going north toward Sharpsburg Road –**

- Continue heading north on I-37.
- Take **Exit 20B**, going north (*about a 6-mile drive which is about a 5-minute drive*).
- Continue on Exit 20B ramp, turn right, then first left to get onto bridge overpass.
- Continue on bridge overpass, turn right, then right again to get onto I-37 going south.
- Take **Exit 16, I-37 South. Please note. There is no southbound exit into Labonte Park.**
- Please follow TxDOT signs to exit from I-37 South leading to **Ripple Road**.
- **CAUTION – At highway exit ramp, check for traffic exiting from Labonte Park heading toward Ripple Road.**
- From **Ripple Road**, turn left.
- Go through the underpass of I-37 and turn left.
- Keep on the **I-37 Frontage Road** (northbound access road) to get to Labonte Park.

## Option 3 of 3 – Getting to Labonte Park

### Driving in from Victoria, Houston, San Antonio, heading South to Labonte Park

Please plan accordingly. [View map of Labonte Park on \(Google Maps\)](#).

- **Driving in from Victoria and Houston, you will have to merge onto I-37 North –**

- From **I-69 East** merge onto **I-37 North** as if you're heading to San Antonio.
- Take **Exit 20B**, going north (*about a 3-mile drive which is about a 3-minute drive*).
- Continue on Exit 20B ramp, turn right, then first left to get onto bridge overpass.
- Continue on bridge overpass, turn right, then right again to get onto I-37 going south.
- Follow next section, 'driving in from San Antonio'.

- **Driving in from San Antonio –**

- Take **Exit 16, I-37 South**. **Please note**. There is no southbound exit into Labonte Park.
- Please follow TxDOT signs to exit from I-37 South leading to **Ripple Road**.
- **CAUTION – At highway exit ramp, check for traffic exiting Labonte Park heading toward Ripple Road.**
- From **Ripple Road**, turn left.
- Go through the underpass of I-37 and turn left.
- Keep on the **I-37 Frontage Road** (access road) going north to get to Labonte Park.
- **CAUTION – Do not follow the northbound exit ramp as you will get on I-37 heading north. \***
- **Please note**. Upon arrival, before entering Labonte Park, at the end of the I-37 Frontage Road (access road), **there is a bridge height (vertical) clearance of 18ft - 0in. If your RV and/or vehicle height exceeds the bridge height (vertical) clearance, you will not be able to enter Labonte Park and you will be stuck at the underpass.**

**\* If you mistakenly took the exit ramp toward I-37 North –**

- Continue heading north on I-37.
- Take **Exit 20B**, going north (*about a 5-mile drive which is about a 4-minute drive*).
- Continue on Exit 20B ramp, turn right, then first left to get onto bridge overpass.
- Continue on bridge overpass, turn right, then right again to get onto I-37 going south.
- **Go to the 'San Antonio' section and follow all steps to get to Labonte Park.**

### Option 1 of 2 – Leaving Labonte Park

#### Driving to either Corpus Christi or Kingsville from Labonte Park

- **CAUTION** – Follow the I-37 South travel direction when departing from Labonte Park.
- **CAUTION** – At highway exit ramp, **YIELD** to traffic exiting from I-37 South.
- From the **I-37 Frontage Road** (access road), follow the exit ramp toward I-37 South.
- Follow highway signs on **I-37 South** to get to your destination.

### Option 2 of 2 – Leaving Labonte Park

#### Driving to either Victoria, Houston, San Antonio, from Labonte Park

Please plan accordingly. [View map of Labonte Park on \(Google Maps\)](#).

- **CAUTION** – Follow the I-37 South travel direction when departing from Labonte Park.
- **CAUTION** – At highway exit ramp, **YIELD** to traffic exiting from I-37 South.
- After yielding at the I-37 South highway exit ramp, keep on the **I-37 Frontage Road** (access road) going toward **Ripple Road**.
- **CAUTION** – Do not follow the southbound exit ramp as you will get on I-37 heading south.
- From **Ripple Road**, turn left.
- Go through the underpass of I-37 and turn left.
- Keep on the **I-37 Frontage Road** (access road) going north.
- From the **I-37 Frontage Road** (access road), follow the exit ramp toward I-37 North.
- **CAUTION** – Do not follow the I-37 Frontage Road (access road) going north as this will take you to Labonte Park.
- Follow highway signs on **I-37 North** to get to your destination.
